eCampus Upgrade – January 3rd and 4th

During the winter break, eCampus will be unavailable on January 3rd and 4th as it is being upgraded to a new version. The system will be down during that period but should be online again January 5, 2011. For the most part, users will not notice a major a difference in the way eCampus operates after the upgrade, but there will be a few enhancements and new tools to consider. Feel free to continue working on your upcoming courses, as all current courses will remain "as is" after the upgrade.
